Key Components

<p>Science (S): The Growth of Patience in Nature</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: Galatians 6:9 (NIV)</p> <p>"Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Reflection: How does nature teach us patience? Consider how a seed takes time to grow into a tree. How can this natural process reflect the way patience strengthens faith and character in our lives?
<p>Technology (S): The Role of Patience in Innovation</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: Proverbs 14:29 (NIV)</p> <p><i>"Whoever is patient has great understanding, but one who is quick-tempered displays folly."</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Reflection: Many technological advancements required patience and perseverance. Think about God's grace and patience during the process of innovation and breakthroughs –how does patience lead to greater understanding and success?

Engineering (E): Building with Patience	<p>Scripture Focus: Hebrews 6:15 (NIV)</p> <p><i>"And so after waiting patiently, Abraham received what was promised."</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Reflection: Consider how engineers and builders must carefully plan and construct projects over time. How does this process relate to waiting on God's promises in your own life?
Arts (A): Expressing Patience Through Creativity	<p>Scripture Focus: Ecclesiastes 7:8 (NIV)</p> <p><i>"The end of a matter is better than its beginning, and patience is better than pride."</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Reflection: Artists, musicians, and writers know that great work takes time. How does patience in the creative process help us appreciate the journey instead of rushing to the end result?
Math (M): Patience and Time	<p>Scripture Focus: Psalm 37:7 (NIV)</p> <p><i>"Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes."</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Project: Time often serves as a measure of our faith, testing our patience and strengthening our reassurance in God's plan. How is time compared to endurance when it comes patience?

Social Studies (SS): Patience in History and Society

Scripture Focus: Romans 12:12 (NIV)

"Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."

- **Reflection:** Many figures in the Bible demonstrated patience while working toward justice. How can we practice patience in our own communities while working for positive change?
