Key Components

Science (S): Science of Harmony	Scripture Focus: Genesis 1:31 - <i>"God saw all that he had made, and it was very good."</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Reflection: Given that God is the creator of peace, what are things around us that seem to be perfect peace?
Technology (S): Technology for Peace	Scripture Focus: Proverbs 16:7 - <i>"When the Lord takes pleasure in anyone's way, he causes their enemies to make peace with them."</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Reflection: How can God use you positively to foster peace?

<p>Engineering (E): Building Bridges, Not Walls</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: Matthew 5:9 - "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reflection: God wants to use us as tools to inspire peace among each other and rely on Him for His goodness, grace and mercy. How can you be a "bridge builder" in your community?
<p>Arts (A): The Art of Peace</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: Isaiah 26:3 - <i>"You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast because they trust in you."</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reflection: How does your God given talents help you express and experience peace?
<p>Math (M): Mathematical Equations of Peace</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: Romans 12:18 - "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reflection: Given your everyday interactions may not pan out how you want it, God's peace is omnipresent. What components do you need to balance your life for peace?
<p>Social Studies (SS): What is Peace?</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: Philippians 4:7 - "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reflection: God provides peace to us through His Son, Jesus Christ, who gave His life and died for our sins. This

	peace protects our hearts and minds, grounding us in God's love even amid life's challenges. Through Christ, we are invited to experience a peace that is steady, unshakable, and eternal. What does peace through Jesus Christ mean to you?
