Key Components

Science (S): The Natural World and Creation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ Topic: Investigate the creation narrative in Genesis 1-2, focusing on the natural order, the environment, and the creation of life.❖ Project: Creation Sequence Model: Create a detailed model or digital representation that illustrates the sequence of creation as described in Genesis 1. Highlight the order of creation and the relationship between different elements of the natural world.

Focus on the dimensions and materials mentioned in the text to create a visual representation that remains true to the biblical narrative.</p> <p>Engineering Challenges: Explore the engineering challenges that Noah might have encountered during the construction of the Ark, as described in the Bible. Consider the resources available at the time and how these challenges were addressed according to the scriptural account.</p>
<p>Arts (A): Creative Expression of Genesis Themes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Topic: Interpret the themes of creation, human fallibility, and the flood through art. ❖ Projects: <p>Visual Representation: Create a piece of visual art that depicts the stages of creation, the fall, or the flood narrative. This could be a painting, drawing, or digital art piece.</p> <p>Literary Interpretation: Write a poem, song, or narrative that explores the themes of Genesis 1-8, such as creation, sin, and redemption.</p>

<p>Mathematics (M): Analyzing Biblical Measurements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Topic: Explore the mathematical concepts present in Genesis, particularly in the construction of Noah’s Ark. ❖ Project: Ark Capacity Calculation: Calculate the length and width of Noah’s Ark based on the biblical dimensions. Compare these figures with modern ships or large structures to understand the scale.
<p>Social Studies (SS): Historical and Cultural Context</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Topic: Examine the historical and cultural backdrop of Genesis 1-8, and its influence on subsequent religious and societal developments. ❖ Project: Impact on Society: Research and present on how the stories and themes of Genesis 1-8 have influenced various aspects of culture, including literature, art, and social structures, throughout history.
