Justice will return to the righteous, and all the upright in heart will follow it."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Project Idea: Design a model or blueprint for a community project, like a free pantry or safe gathering space, that embodies love and justice. ● Reflection: How does building spaces of support and care reflect God's commitment to love and justice?
<p>Arts (A): Expressing Love through Creativity</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: Psalm 34:14</p> <p>"Turn away from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Project Idea: Create a piece of art (painting, poem, or song) that illustrates the power of love in promoting peace and love. ● Reflection: How does expressing love through creativity inspire others to seek goodness and reflect God's love?

<p>Math (M): Measuring the Impact of Love</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: 1 Corinthians 13:13</p> <p><i>"So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love."</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Project Idea: Track and analyze acts of kindness over a week, creating a chart to show how small actions contribute to a larger impact. ● Reflection: How does quantifying love's impact help us recognize its importance in our daily lives?
<p>Social Studies (SS): God's Love Through History</p>	<p>Scripture Focus: John 3:16</p> <p><i>"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Project Idea: Research and present stories of historical figures or movements inspired by God's love. ● Reflection: How have acts of love shaped the course of history and inspired change in society?
