Arts (A): Expressing Care and	Scripture Focus: Romans 12:15 (NIV)
Understanding Creatively	"Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn."
Objective:	
<ul> <li>Explore how creative outlets can communicate compassion, tell others' stories, and encourage patience through shared experiences.</li> </ul>	Reflection: How can art— whether visual, musical, or written— help you step into someone else's shoes?
Math (M): Measured Responses and Wise	Scripture Focus: Ephesians 4:2 (NIV)
Timing	"Be completely humble and gently; be patient, bearing with one another in love."
Objective:	
<ul> <li>Recognize the importance of timing and proportion in responses, much like calculations in mathematics.</li> <li>Consider how patience requires a deliberate choice to respond with wisdom.</li> </ul>	Reflection: Think of a recent time you reacted too quickly. How might waiting or measuring your words and actions have changed the outcome?
